Parking:

We continue to have parents who are dropping off and picking up their children in areas that are clearly marked as 'no stopping' zones. Of primary concern are the two cul de sacs on the north and south sides of the school where each day parents make the choice to drop their children off. Students who are dropped off in these areas are forced to maneuver through parked and moving cars, creating an environment that is simply not safe. Additionally, the families in our community who live in these no stopping zones are having a difficult time getting in and out of their driveways during drop off and pick up times, which leads to anger and frustration.

We ask that all families who make the choice to drive their child/ children to school do so with the intent of using the drop off bay in front of the school or finding a legal parking spot on the street.

Lunches:

A reminder to parents that if you are dropping off a lunch for your child, we ask that you drop it off at the lunch table outside of the gym, not at the classroom door or window. If you need to speak to your child at lunch please have them meet them at the lunch table or ask the office staff to call them down.

Dress for the Weather:

At Fraser Wood, students are often given the choice to go outside at recess and lunch even if it is raining heavily. On these 'choice days' students will not be permitted outside without reasonable wet weather clothing.

Last week, students came home with an invitation for parents to join us for meet the teacher night on Wednesday, September the 23rd from 6-7pm. We hope to see you there.
